

Sorry, I don't speak English

Puzzle

Preparation

- Make copies of the puzzle on different coloured sheets, laminate and cut up.
- Print a few copies of the puzzle as a handout for learners to self-check.

Tip: If you print each set of cards on different coloured paper, this will make it easier for you to check that all the cards are returned to each set before you re-use.

Instructions

1. In pairs or small groups learners match the different parts of the puzzle.
2. When learners have checked their answers, ask learners to tell each other personal examples using the same beginning of each sentence, e.g.
 - *When I start a new class, I feel nervous.*
 - *I feel shy when I speak English.*
3. Elicit a range of adverbs of degree, e.g. *very, really, so, quite, a little.*
4. Ask learners to work with a different partner and tell each other different personal examples using a range of adverbs of degree.

Extension activity

- Ask learners to write their examples and add more if they can.
